There are several ways you can use SharePoint and Questionmark Perception together:

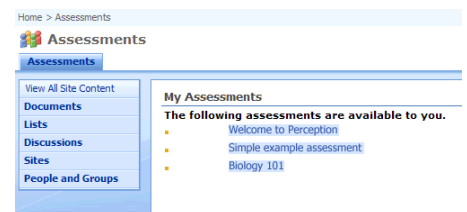
- Embed a quiz or survey in a SharePoint portal page, wiki or blog.
- Provide single sign-on access to assessments – allowing participants to view and launch Questionmark assessments assigned to them from within SharePoint.

This is possible:

- Using a standard SharePoint "page-viewer" web part (if your organisation uses Windows authentication)
- Using Questionmark's SharePoint Connector. When initialised, the Connector calls the Perception server using the current SharePoint user's login name as the participant name and receives a list of assessments scheduled for that participant and display a list of links to those assessments.

SharePoint Connector Overview

SharePoint Connector is an add-on that integrates Perception with Microsoft SharePoint. SharePoint Connector is a "web part" that can be used with SharePoint, and which allows a participant logged into SharePoint single-sign-on access to assessments in Perception. Now just as users might have access to "My Calendar", "My email" and/or "My Address Book" they can access their customised assessments from a "My Assessments" window.



Once Questionmark Perception is integrated with SharePoint using Questionmark SharePoint Portal Server Connector, a new menu header appears called "My Assessments." Under "My Assessments," the logged-in user sees a list of the quizzes, tests and surveys that have been scheduled for them. Clicking on one of the assessment links causes the assessment to start. When the assessment is completed, the results are stored within the Perception database for future analysis, and the user can be provided any appropriate feedback
