



Questionmark Perception Export to Excel

Analyse data using a powerful and familiar tool

Background

Questionmark Perception's add-on Export to Excel makes it possible to export answer data from Questionmark™ Perception™ assessments into the Microsoft Excel spreadsheet format. User privileges restrict access to users so that they can only export the data that they are allowed to see.

Why Export to Excel?

Excel's graphing and formatting power can be of great benefit to people who run computerised assessments. Export to Excel expands the power of Perception's 10 built-in report types by enabling you to send results to Excel for further analysis and graphing. Excel doesn't provide all of the statistical analysis or presentation capabilities required to investigate the reliability and validity of a test. But it does provide a great visual environment to help Perception users derive meaning from data.

What it does

Export to Excel feature enables Perception users to analyse their assessment results and scores in Excel 2000 and Excel XP. The new feature puts all the Excel's data handling and graphing tools directly into the hands of Perception users. Perception's security system ensures that users only export the data that they have privileges to see.

How it works

If you are using Perception 3.4.2, you can export Perception results directly into a Microsoft Excel document by running the Enterprise Manager Export for Excel report type. This is an add-on to Perception that you can obtain from Questionmark Communities.

If you are using an earlier version of Perception (3.1.1 or above), you can use the Enterprise Manager Export to ASCII report type.

Once you have run the Export for Excel install program you can begin running Export for Excel reports.

With Export to Excel you can:

- Display results in Excel instead of your browser
- Analyse data with a powerful and familiar tool
- Configure and format reports to represent the data in an easy to understand style
- Utilise all the graphing and formatting power of Excel

Additional Options

Perception can store results in MS Access, MS SQL or Oracle database formats. In addition to Export to Excel, answers and results can be extracted using a series of application program interfaces (APIs) known as Questionmark Web Integrated Services Environment (QMWise). This comprehensive series of web services methods enable registration, management and reporting systems to tightly integrate with Questionmark Perception.
