### General information

Purpose of assessment	A diagnostic assessment to measure people managers' knowledge and understanding of anti-discrimination law in the UK.
Target audience	Intermediate-level managers and supervisors of organisations operating in the UK, i.e. employees who oversee other team members and make employment decisions.
Limitations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The test only provides a limited coverage of the subject, enough to identify critical problems</li> <li>- Applies to a limited geographic area</li> <li>- The results cannot be used as an only source of information about the candidate's knowledge</li> </ul>
What does it mean to achieve a high score?	The participant has demonstrated a good level of understanding of anti-discrimination law on employment and team management.

What does it mean to achieve a low score?	There may be critical gaps in the participant's understanding of anti-discrimination law and may require additional training.
Language	Test is presented in UK English.
Blooms taxonomy cognitive level	30% Understanding and 70% Applying
Format	Online test presented in Questionmark software, automatically scored.
Accessibility	The test uses an accessible design.
Time limit	30 min
Number of questions	15 items
Scoring	One point per question. No negative scoring

Feedback	<p>Participant to be given at end of test:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Overall score</li> <li>- Question level feedback for wrong answers, giving the correct answer(s) and explanation(s)</li> </ul> <p>Since the score on each topic is based on a relatively small number of questions, it is advisable that the results of this test should not be the only source of information to evaluate the test taker's knowledge of anti-discrimination legislation.</p>
