Understanding Templates

Template structure

- Templates follow the structure to the right
- Most changes are made in the *Settings* and *Text* categories

• Settings:

o Turn on/off functionalityo Change graphics

• Text

o Change UI text labelso Change UI translations

Which Settings Take Precedence

Prioritization of templates

question

- System defaults contain all available entries and their default values
- Area-wide defaults can be used to make setting/text changes on your whole environment
- Assessment-specific settings take priority over all previous settings but only apply to the specific assessment
- Block-specific templates have the highest priority

How to Add Your Own Log to an Assessment Setting Entry: HEADER GRAPHIC

- HEADER_GRAPHIC allows us to change the logo being used
- Upload new logo and set the new graphic name in the value field below

How to Add Your Own Log to an Assessment

File Locations

- Authoring > Resources is where we upload our templates and associated resources
- The **xtmpgfx** folder is where all our template graphics go
- The **defaults** folder contain the system default setting and text files
 - Every delivery setting can be found in the *qmDefaultSettings* file
 - Every delivery UI text entry can be found in the **qmDefaultText** file
 - *Never* make changes directly to these files as system updates will overwrite them
- The **templates** folder contains all available templates and is where we will upload our new/updated template to

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How to Change Assessment Behavior

Examples of assessment behavior changes

- Scrolling or QxQ delivery
- Options for the submit button
 - Show *immediately*
 - o Show once all questions have been seen
 - Show once all questions have been *answered*
- Displaying assessment navigator
- Enabling/disabling the use of shortcut keys, such as *Alt* and *Ctrl*
- Amending when the time limit warning appears
- Many more...
- Remember, all settings can be found in the *qmDefaultSettings* file

How to Change Assessment Behavior

Understanding Boolean and integers

- Most template settings will expect either a *Boolean* or *Integer* entry
- In layman's terms:
 - Boolean = **ON** or **OFF**
 - 1 = **ON**
 - 0 = **OFF**
- In the Boolean example on the right, we can turn the setting USE_QXQ off by changing the value to 0
- Where Boolean is always on/off integer settings will have more than 2 values
- In the integer example on the right the *value* can be either *0*, *1* or *2*
- Questionmark *ALWAYS* list the possible options within the *description* field, if you don't see a list of options that means it is an ON/OFF (Boolean) setting

Understanding text entries

- **Descriptions** will explain what the text is used for
- There is a *value* for each language entry
- To change the submit text:
 - Find the corresponding language code for the language you want to change
 - en-US for English
 - Change the *value* entry
- All text entries are found in the *qmDefaultText* file

How to Add Tools to Your Template

What are tools?

question

- Tools are resources that can be added to the assessment navigator
- Available throughout the assessment and they appear as a pop-up when clicked
- Any resource accessible through a URL should be possible to add
- Examples:
 - Calculator
 - Periodic Table
 - PDF files

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Taking branding further

CSS

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- **CSS** = Cascading Style Sheets
- **CSS** is the technology responsible for the **presentation** of web pages
- Knowledge of **CSS** allows great flexibility in changing the look of your assessment
- Allows you to closely align with your company branding
- **CSS** can be placed **internally** within the template or within an **external** file that you can reference from the template
- **CSS** can be complicated to understand
